Notes:

A) Qualifications for Registration as per section 5 of the Act.

(1) Subject to section 6, a person is entitled to be registered as an engineer under this Act if, on application made to the Board, he satisfies the Board that:

- (a) he is qualified to be so registered; and
- (b) he is a fit and proper person to practise engineering in Barbados.

(2) For the purpose of subsection (1), a person is qualified to be registered as an engineer if:-

- (a) he has been awarded
 - (i) a degree in engineering by the University of the West Indies, or
 - (ii) a degree, diploma or other qualification in engineering granted by a University or School of engineering that, in the opinion of the Board, is evidence of satisfactory training in engineering; and
- (b) he has had not less than four (4) years of such experience in engineering, as the Board approves.

B) The applicant must furnish to the Secretary of the Board together with the application

- (a) evidence of his qualifications and experience
 - NB. Originals are to be provided. These will be returned to the applicant. (Six copies of all documents submitted must accompany the application)**
- (b) proof of his identity; and
- (c) such further and other information as the Board requires in respect of the matters relating to the application.
